

This week we will be starting our topic on Spiders. We will be reading the book Aaaarrgghh Spider. If you can, read the book with your child at home or watch the story on YouTube.



On Wednesday afternoon we will be going on a Spider Hunt to Heston Park to look for spiders and their webs. We will be making spiders from clay and junk and webs from PVA glue and glitter. We will then be writing labels for our models using our sounds e.g. It has 8 legs. The children should all now be able to sounds these words out by saying them like a robot and then writing the letters.

In Maths we will be learning about 2D shapes such as triangles, circles, squares and rectangles. We will be learning to describe the shapes by saying how many sides and corners each one has. We will be making our own shapes with sticks and playing 'Guess the Shape'. Please help your children by pointing out and talking about the different shapes you can see at home and outside.

In RE we will be thanking God for spiders and all the creatures that he has made. We will make up our own prayer for the spiders. We are also going to church on a shape hunt to see what shapes are important in our faith.

This week your 50p's have helped the teachers to buy pumpkins and different types of squash for our Autumn tables. Thank you as this helps with the children's learning.
