PRIVATE & BUILDING FUND

As a voluntary aided Catholic school, the price pay we pay for our independence is that we must find 10% of all capital costs. It is therefore essential that all parents contribute to the development and maintenance of the school's premises as well as providing new equipment for the benefit of the children. We ask that you make contributions to the following funds:

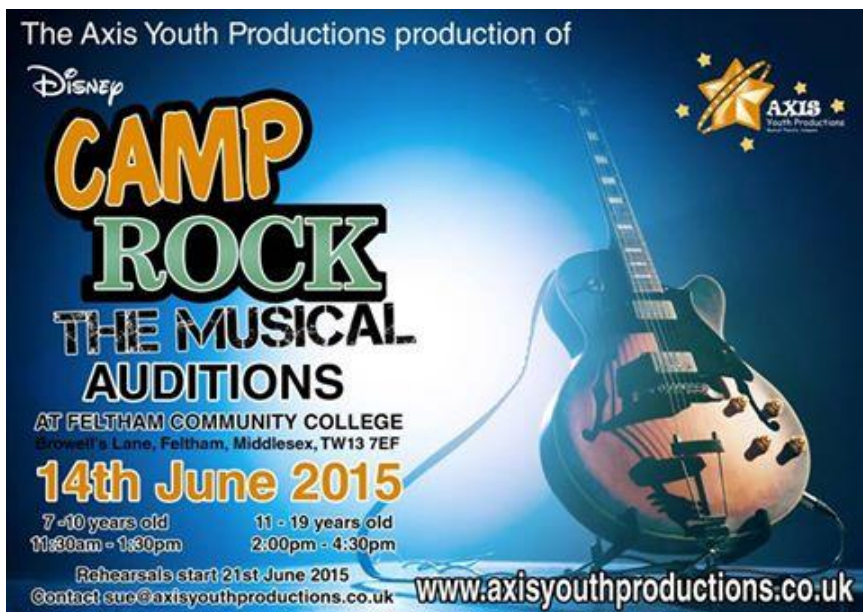
+ Private School Fund

We ask for a contribution of **£10** per child each year, payable in September. The Private fund helps to buy many extras for the children as well as subsidise school journeys, necessities and treats.

+ School Building Fund

This fund is for the maintenance of our school and others in the Diocese of Westminster. It enables essential repairs and maintenance to be undertaken. We ask for a contribution of **£25** per child each year (a reduction may be arranged for families with three or more children attending the school).

If you have not done so already it is not too late to pay your contributions via ParentPay.
